

# GUESSING GAME: HOW MANY BOTTLE CAPS?

Bottle caps can be repurposed in so many ways! Along with art projects, games are another fun way to give your caps a second life. We've provided some basic instructions for just one of the many interactive and fun games that you can play with bottle caps in the classroom.

## ***What You'll Need:***

- 1 liter or larger clear plastic container
- 150-200 bottle caps



## ***What to Do:***

1. Count out and record the number of bottle caps that you'll want to use for the game – a number between 100-200 is usually a good amount!
2. Fill the container with the caps you have collected.
3. Pass the container around to the students. On a slip of paper, have them write down how many caps they think are in the container.
4. Once they've all written down their guesses, go around the classroom and collect students' answers.
5. Review the guesses out loud and name the winner!
6. For some extra encouragement, offer a prize to the student whose guess comes closest to the actual number of caps, such as giving the student an extra bonus punch on their recycling punch cards.
